The VoKa project, a Target Research Program, aims to critically assess the current state of military education, reflecting on its organization, professional career development, and the institutional challenges faced within the Slovenian context while also drawing on international comparisons.

The research methodology encompasses a thorough review of relevant literature, legal-administrative regulations, and comparative case studies, synthesizing theoretical and practical perspectives on military education. The results put forward a compelling case for establishing a military academy, enhanced international exchanges, and the necessity for reforms incorporating interdisciplinary scientific research into educational frameworks.

The anticipated reforms, underscored by the VoKa project's findings, stress the urgency of a comprehensive overhaul of military education systems to meet the demands of modern defense strategies and security challenges. By emphasizing the value of scientific inquiry, international mobility, and the fusion of civil expertise with military training, the research posits that a reformed military education system will increase operational readiness and efficiency and promote a more adaptive and forward-looking military profession.

The presentation delineates strategic recommendations for future research and practical steps for advancing military education systems, ensuring their relevance and adaptability in an ever-changing global security environment.
